Instead, Rory (like Jonah) jumps on a cruise ship after mailing the letter instead. But disasters follow as a result and Rory is faced with trying to save the sinners he abhors: prostitutes, drug addicts, gamblers and gangs. And, like Chynoweth's other novels, a little romance enters the mix when Rory falls in love with feisty Police Lt. Susan McAfree who is part of his investigation team.

Yet even though The Runaway Prophet may be a bit spicier than her former award-winning novels, the book still delivers an inspirational message to today's readers that correlates to what God is trying to tell us in the Old Testament story: that you can try to run from God's call but you can't hide, and sometimes when you try to rescue other people, God rescues you in the process.
